#### Path Through the Bible

Say: \*Jesus shows us the right path, and we can trace that path all the way back through the Bible. We're going to make a little fold-out book that'll help you trace that path and remind you of it whenever you're wondering about which path to take in life.

Lead kids to your craft area where you've set out scissors, glue sticks, and copies of the "Pathway Through the Bible" handout (p. 123).

Help kids through the following steps to complete the handout.

- Cut out the two long sections.
- ✓ Make one long strip by gluing the tab at the end of the first section to the back of the second section.
- ✓ Accordion fold the pages to form a book.

When kids have their books assembled, say: We have here five verses from throughout the Bible, starting toward the beginning and finishing with the words of Jesus, and they're all talking about the same path. The challenge for you is to read them and discover what path they're talking about.

Select child volunteers to read the five Bible verses. Help them discover together that God's path, Jesus' path, is one of love.
